PARENTS & CHILD CAREGIVERS

If you are feeling OVERWHELMED, stressed, anxious or isolated: Keep in touch with friends and family members. Keeping connected to others helps reduce stress, anxiety and frustration. Take a little time to do something for yourself such as exercise, stretch, read, etc.

Keep Yourself and Your Children Busy: Schedule family activities: board games, family movie-time, walks. Laughter and physical activity are great stress reducers.

STAY TUNED IN: Remain informed about COVID-19 news. Manage and balance your news intake and take a break/ disconnect for a while when you're feeling increased fear or anxiety.
